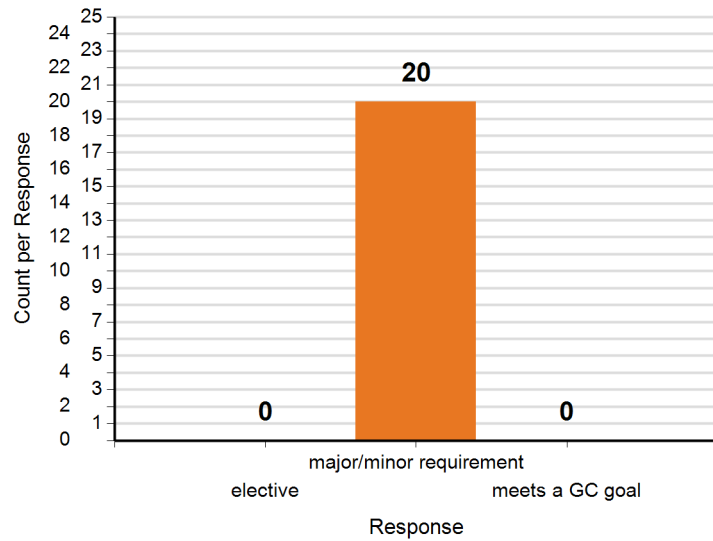

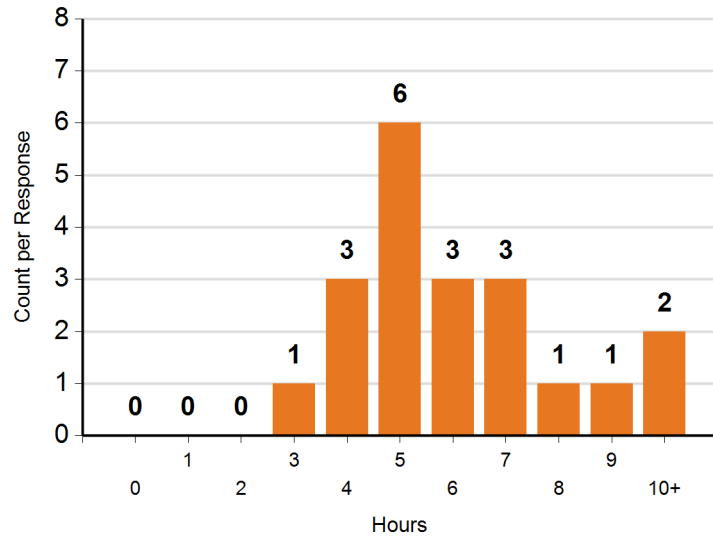

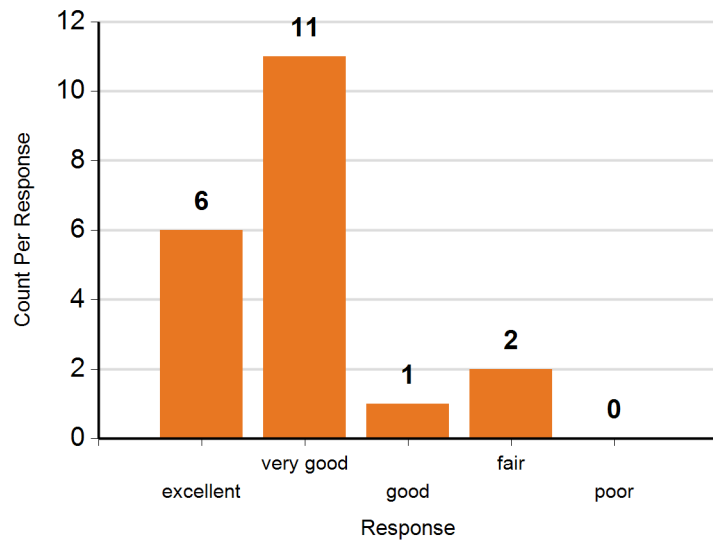
**Q1 - Why did you take this course? (Student can select up to 3 responses)**

For this class I put a lot of effort for this class, so I did not fall behind. I could have participation in class, but for assignments I put in a lot of work to understanding the topics.

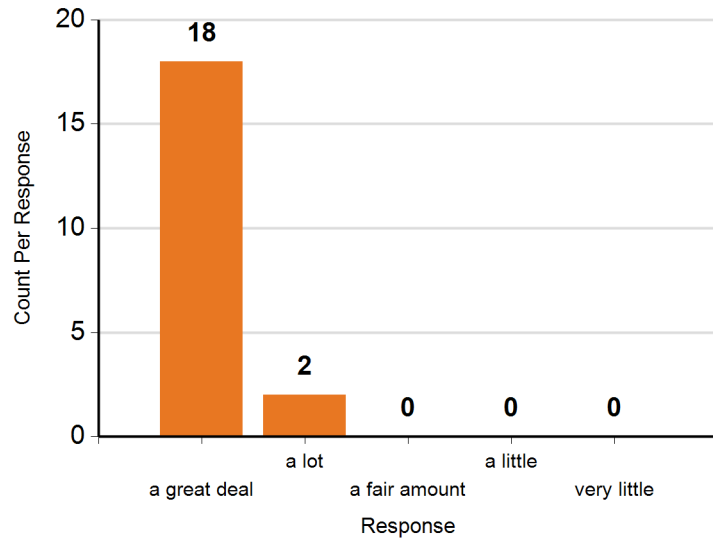
I believe I could've done a better job meeting with the professor. He does a great job making time for students.

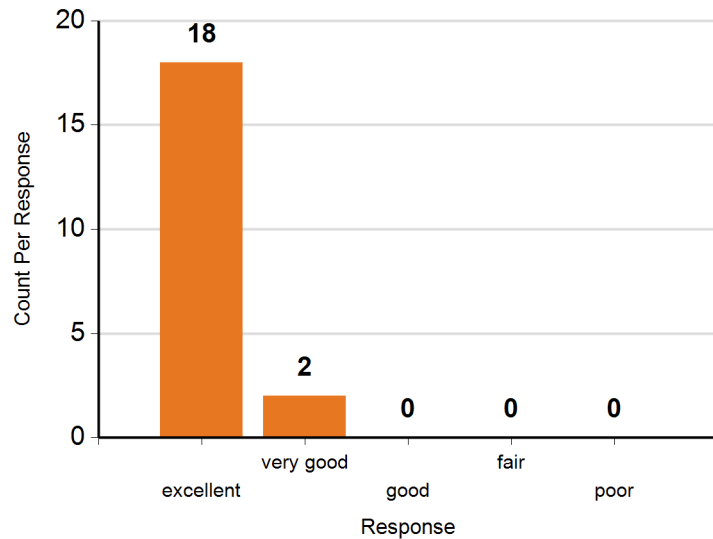

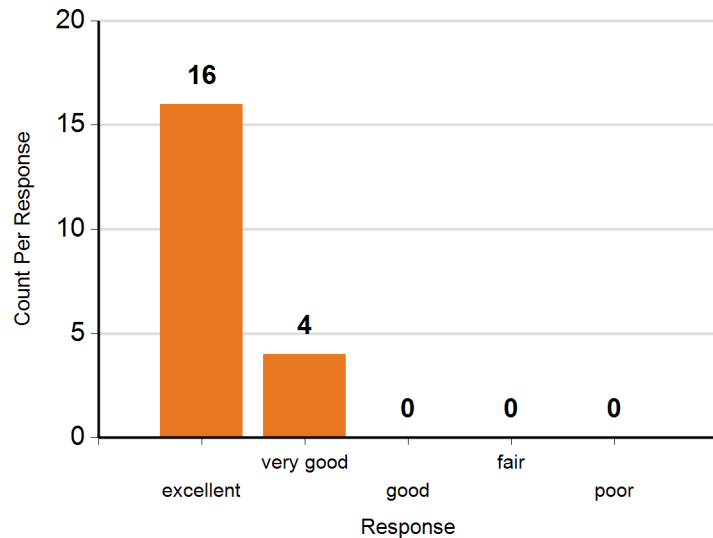

I never felt like we were wasting time in class, and I knew that this was a class I needed to show up ready to pay attention

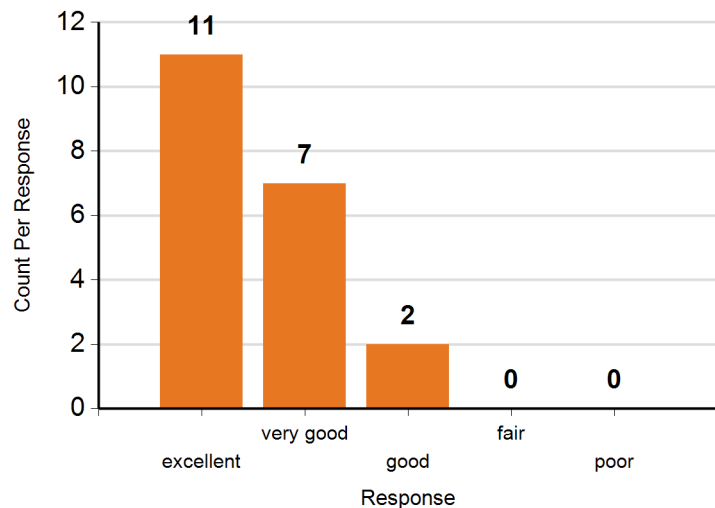

The professor prepared us enough to know what is going to be on the exam to test us fairly.

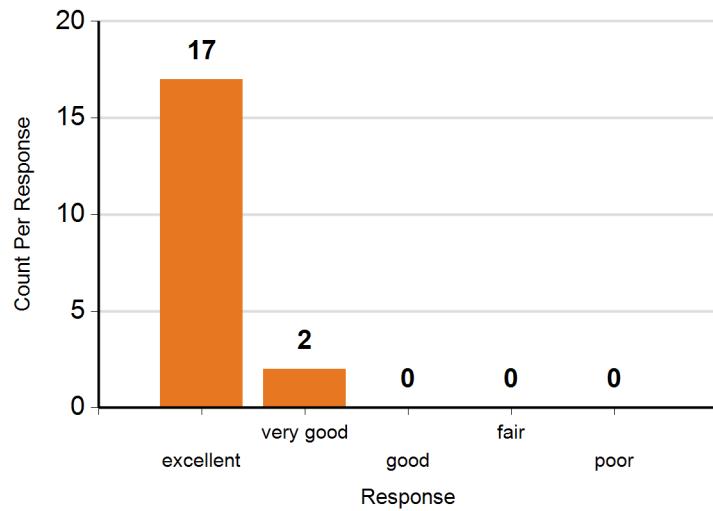

Professor Lin went out of his way to provide sincere and in-depth commentary on my assignments. He would even email me individually when he thought of something that he felt could help me.

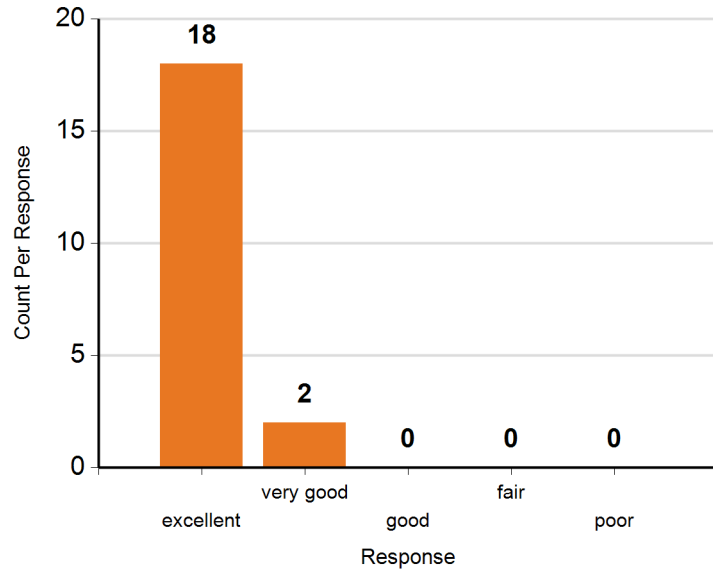

The instructor was excellent in providing resources and feedback to learn. Every assignment felt like there is a purpose behind in to help use learn instead of just it being busy work.

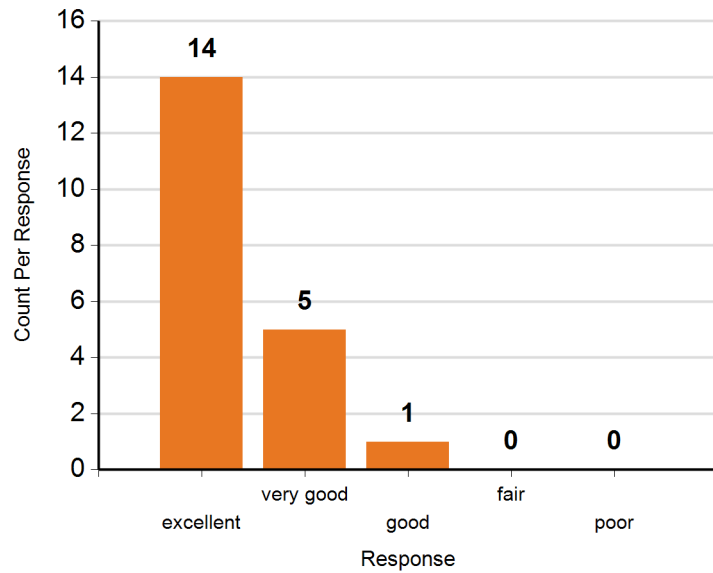
